Day 2
Read Exodus 2:5-10

Moses is one of my favorite people in the Bible.
He loved God and chose to follow Him through difficult circumstances.

Who found Moses as a baby? _____
What was he floating in? _____

Can you imagine floating in water in a basket? That's not something we see every day!
Moses' mom had placed him in the basket to keep him safe from Pharaoh,
the ruler of Egypt who wanted to hurt young baby boys.
Pharaoh's daughter saw the baby in the basket and decided to rescue him,
adopting him as her son.

God protected Moses in the basket and brought him to a safe place.
Pray and thank God for protecting you and keeping you safe, just like baby Moses.
Thank Him that you can trust Him.

Day 3
Read Exodus 3:2-4, 10-12

What did God speak to Moses from? _____

God spoke to Moses from a burning bush! Even though it was on fire,
it was not destroyed by the flames. How awesome!
Pharaoh had made the Israelites slaves in Egypt and was very mean to them.
God asked Moses to do a very important job:
bring God's people, the Israelites, out of Egypt to rescue them from Pharaoh.
Moses was nervous about such a big task, but God said to him
"I will be with you" (verse 12).
Moses obeyed God because he trusted Him.

God is with you, too, everywhere, everyday.
Do you have things that seem too big for you at school or at home?
Ask God to give you strength like he gave Moses.
Thank Him for being with you in every situation.

Day 4
Read Exodus 4:10-15

What was Moses scared of doing? _____

Moses was insecure about his ability to speak to the Israelites. God said to Him, "...I will **help** you speak and will **teach** you what to say." (verse 12)

Moses was still nervous about talking to such a large crowd and worried that they would not believe what he told them.

God fulfilled His promise to help Moses, and gave him his brother, Aaron, who was a great speaker and would help Moses speak to the people.

God wants to help you, too, just like He helped Moses.

Is there anything you are scared of doing? Ask God to help you. God will never ask you to do something without providing a way to do it!

Day 5
Read Psalm 62:8

Fill in the blanks to the verse:

For God is our _____."*

God tells us to trust Him at ALL times. That means that we trust God when things are going well, and we also trust Him when we are sad, disappointed or scared... we choose to trust Him **all** the time! The dictionary defines "refuge" as shelter or protection from danger or distress. If God is our refuge, then that means that He is our protector, guarding us with His mighty power and keeping us safe from harm.
