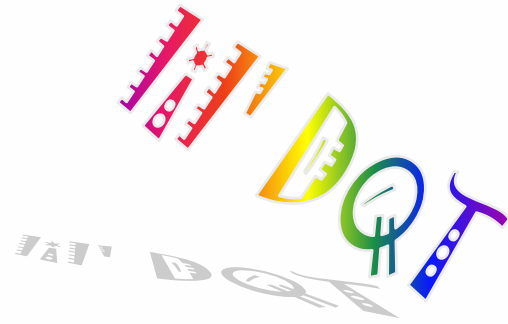

Day 1

Memory Verse: Proverbs 3:5-6

This week we will talk about Moses,
a man in the Bible who trusted God.
God is with you everywhere you go!
Draw a picture below of you and God
Walking together.

Pray and thank God that you can trust Him because
He loves you and wants the best for you.

Day 2
Read Exodus 2:5-10

Can you imagine floating in water in a basket? That's not something we see every day! Moses' mom had placed him in the basket to keep him safe from Pharaoh, the ruler of Egypt who wanted to hurt young baby boys. Pharaoh's daughter saw the baby in the basket and decided to rescue him, adopting him as her son.

Draw a picture of baby Moses floating in a basket in the river.

Pray and thank God for protecting you, just like baby Moses.

Day 3
Read Exodus 3:2-4, 10-12

God spoke to Moses from a burning bush! How awesome! Pharaoh had made the Israelites slaves in Egypt and was very mean to them. God asked Moses to bring God's people, the Israelites, out of Egypt to rescue them from Pharaoh. Moses was nervous about such a big job, but God said to him "I will be with you." Moses obeyed God because he trusted Him.

Draw a picture of Moses talking to God in the burning bush.

Thank God for hearing your prayers and being with you every day.

Day 4

Read Exodus 4:10-15

Moses was scared of speaking to the Israelites. God told Moses He would help him, so he gave him his brother, Aaron, who was a great speaker and would help Moses speak to the people.

Draw a picture below of the brothers Moses and Aaron.

God wants to help you, too, just like He helped Moses.
Is there anything you are scared of doing? Ask God to help you.
God will never ask you to do something without helping you do it!

Day 5

Read Psalm 62:8

God tells us to trust Him at ALL times.
That means that we trust God when we are happy,
and we also trust Him when we are sad,
disappointed or scared...we choose to trust Him **all** the time!

The word "refuge" means shelter or protection from danger or distress.
If God is our refuge, then that means that He is our protector,
keeping us safe from harm.

Pray and thank God that you can trust Him all the time.
He will take care of you!
