God's Riches At Christ's Expense

While looking up a good definition, I was reminded about a famous acrositic made using the Greek for *Jesus Christ, God's Son, Savior: Iesus Christos, Theou Uos, Soter* (*ch* and *th* work as one letter in Greek). The initials spell *ichthus*, which is the Greek word for *fish*. Now when you see a fish symbol on someone's car or on a necklace, you will better understand this symbol for Jesus.
